✓ Winter Fuel Payments

A tax-free payment made to all pensioners to help with winter energy bills – these are to be restricted to those on benefits and Pension Credit. Util now, Winter Fuel Payments worth up to £300 have been made available to EVERYONE above State Pension age in the UK– but this will no longer be the case from this winter.

Eligibility - You can get a Winter Fuel Payment for Winter 2024 to 2025 if you were born before 23 September 1958. You must also live in England or Wales and get one of the following:

- Pension Credit
- Universal Credit

- income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA)
- Income Support
